Stories from the Grove: Art, Community, and Dignity

In spring 2024, Grove Christian Outreach Center received grant funding from the An Occasion for the Arts Fund for "Stories from the Grove," a project celebrating the strength and identity of the Grove neighborhood through art and personal reflections.

Created by students from James River Elementary School, neighborhood residents, and local artists, the artwork highlighted the experiences of those living in the community. To ensure accessibility, art kits were delivered to homebound residents, allowing them to participate from home.

The artwork was displayed from April to November in what is now The Gathering Place, Grove Christian Outreach Center's free grocery program, where families can choose their own food, preserving dignity and reducing waste.

With WCF support, Stories from the Grove helped foster a sense of belonging, pride, and connection among Grove residents.

Crochet Circle Brings Older Adults Together

Peninsula Agency on Aging (PAA) helps older adults remain independent by providing essential services and combating social isolation.

One such program, The Crochet Circle, brings together individuals 70 and older to learn a new skill, form friendships, and create handcrafted afghans and other useful items. This welcoming weekly gathering keeps participants engaged and connected.

With a grant from the
Williamsburg Community
Foundation's Senior Services
Fund in 2024, The Crochet Circle
launched and is now volunteer-led.
Participants have crocheted over
50 afghans, 10 hat and scarf sets,
12 shopping bags, and 90 holiday
Santas—many donated to fellow
seniors.

One such recipient is a remarkable woman age 106 who continues to live at home with support from her family, PAA, York-Poquoson DSS, and others—proof that small acts of kindness create lasting impact.


